Center Street.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant commits \$25,000 in matching funds for the facility master plan project.

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant hereby designates Jeffrey T. Fike, Mayor, and Joanne M. Smith, City Administrator, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Corry and the Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission; and

Be it FURTHER RESOLVED, that Melinda Meyer and Laura Thomas are hereby designated as Grant Writers to facilitate and assist the City in preparing and obtaining the grant.


