RESOLUTION 26-15

A Resolution of the City of Corry Affirming Support for the Corry-Lawrence Airport and Airport Authority of the City of Corry, and Directing Preparation of Agreement Between the City and the Airport Authority Formalizing the City's Support for the Corry-Lawrence Airport and the Airport Authority.

WHEREAS, in May 2022, the City of Corry (the "City") established the 2022 Airport Authority of the City of Corry (the "Corry Airport Authority") as the successor entity to the administratively terminated 1955 Airport Authority of the City of Corry;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to re-affirm its support for transferring the FAA/BOA sponsorship of the Corry-Lawrence Airport to the Corry Airport Authority from the City; and

WHEREAS, the City also desires to affirm its support Corry-Lawrence Airport and the Corry Airport Authority by means of financial, in-kind, and/or other types of contributions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing background recitals are incorporated into and made a substantive portion of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Sponsorship. The City hereby re-affirms its commitment to assisting the Corry Airport Authority in transferring the sponsorship of the Corry-Lawrence Airport from the City to the Airport Authority.

SECTION 3. Support and Agreement of Support.

A. City Council hereby affirms support for the Corry-Lawrence Airport and the Corry Airport Authority and agrees to work with the Airport Authority to determine an appropriate level of financial and in-kind support for the operation of the Corry-Lawrence Airport and the Airport Authority.

B. City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, the City Solicitor, and Special Counsel to the City for Airport Matters to work with the Airport Authority to develop a memorandum of understanding or agreement that outlines the scope of the relationship between the City and the Airport Authority. The memorandum of understanding or agreement should include, at a minimum, provisions related to financial commitment, in-kind commitment, ownership, insurance requirements, general responsibilities and obligations, and maintenance responsibilities.

SECTION 3. Modification. City Council reserves the right to modify, supplement, or amend the Resolution from time to time by resolution or ordinance.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.
