A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF CORRY TO THE PENNSYLVANIA CREATIVE INDUSTRIES CREATIVE DISTRICTS PROGRAM, AS PROPOSED BY IMPACT CORRY.

WHEREAS, the Corry City Council recognizes the value of the creative, cultural, and historic sectors, powered by the Pennsylvania Creative Industries, Creative Districts Program in supporting communities as they advance walkable, culturally vibrant areas as centers of economic growth, local identity, community engagement, and inclusive revitalization through investment in local creative assets; and

WHEREAS, Impact Corry has been identified as the proposed District Coordinating Organization for the **Corry Stories: Arts. Heritage. Main Street. Community. – Where Community Stories Become Cultural Destinations** in downtown Corry application and is leading a community-driven effort to strengthen and connect Corry's arts, cultural, historic, recreational, tourism, and downtown development assets; and

WHEREAS, the Corry City Council acknowledges the importance of cross-sector partnerships and recognizes the role of local government support in advancing the goals of the Creative Districts Program; and

WHEREAS, the proposed **Corry Stories: Arts. Heritage. Main Street. Community.** in downtown Corry builds upon years of community planning, public engagement, creative placemaking, cultural programming, downtown revitalization, heritage preservation, trail development, tourism promotion, and community storytelling initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the proposed district aligns with the goals of the Corry Community Strategic Plan and the City of Corry Comprehensive Plan by supporting the activation of the city center, strengthening community identity, supporting economic development, improving quality of life, and creating opportunities for residents and visitors alike.

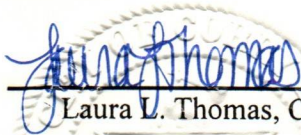

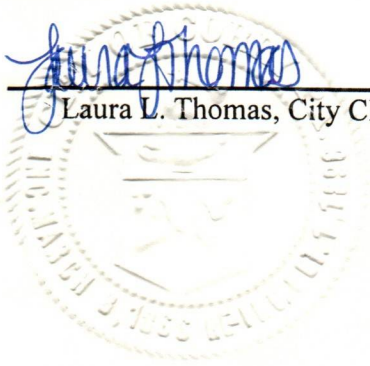
