A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORRY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A STATEWIDE LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CORRY REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Corry is responsible for providing police, fire, and emergency services that protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents while supporting neighboring communities through mutual aid and regional emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the City's existing public safety facilities were constructed for a different era and no longer adequately support modern emergency response operations, equipment, personnel, or regional service responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, requests for assistance from the Corry Police Department and Corry Fire Department continue to increase as volunteer emergency service organizations throughout northwestern Pennsylvania face ongoing operational and workforce challenges; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Corry Regional Public Safety Center will consolidate essential public safety operations into a modern facility that improves emergency response capability, responder safety, operational efficiency, regional coordination, and long-term service capacity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Corry has undertaken extensive planning, engineering, financial preparation, and partnership development to advance this project and has assembled a comprehensive funding strategy leveraging local, county, state, federal, philanthropic, and private investment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that construction of the Corry Regional Public Safety Center is in the public interest and represents a strategic investment that will improve quality of life, strengthen public safety, support economic development, protect public infrastructure, and serve residents throughout the surrounding region;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Corry hereby authorizes submission of an application to the Commonwealth Financing Authority requesting a **Statewide Local Share Account Grant in the amount of \$1,000,000** for the construction of the Corry Regional Public Safety Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council designates:

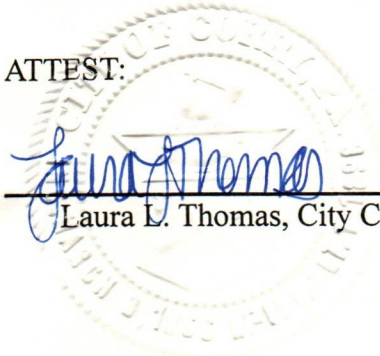
as the authorized officials to execute all applications, certifications, grant agreements, reimbursement requests, and other documents necessary to secure and administer funding associated with this project.

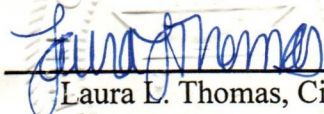

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council affirms its commitment to completing this project in accordance with all applicable Commonwealth Financing Authority requirements and recognizes the Corry Regional Public Safety Center as a priority capital investment critical to the future safety, resilience, and economic vitality of the community.

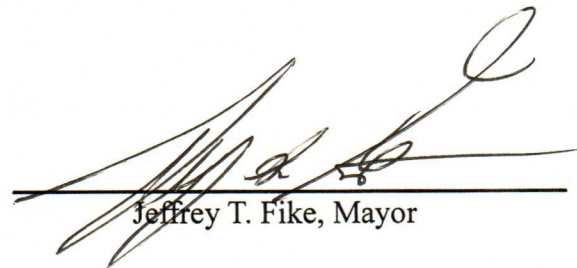
