## **VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OHIO**

## AN ORDINANCE TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CURRENT EXPENSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Council of the Village of Elmore, Ohio met in open session on			
June 10	, 2024.		

WHEREAS, the Council approved an ordinance declaring the necessity to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation; and,

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Auditor ("Auditor") has certified the following information to the Council:

The dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills is:

- Specific number of mills: 3.0
- The County Auditor estimates the dollar amount of revenue to be generated is \$88,000 annually
- This rate is \$105 for each \$100,000 of the County Auditor's appraised value.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ALL THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL CONCURRING, AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to O.R.C. Section 5705.03 (B):

**Section 1.** The Village shall proceed with the submission of the question of the tax to electors.

<u>Section 2.</u> The rate of the tax levy is 3.0 mills for each one dollar of taxable value, and the rate or estimated rate in dollars for each one hundred thousand dollars of the County Auditor's appraised value, as estimated by the County Auditor, is \$105.

<u>Section 3.</u> The additional levy is for the purpose of providing funding for payment of the current expenses of the Village of Elmore, as provided in O.R.C. 5705.19(A); and

Section 4. The proposed levy is an additional tax, at the rate of three (3.00) mills; and

<u>Section 5.</u> The Ohio Revised Code Section authorizing submission of the question of the tax to all residents in the Village of Elmore in Ottawa and Sandusky counties, State of Ohio, is O.R.C. 5705.19(A); and

<u>Section 6.</u> The additional tax levy is for a five (5) year period, commencing in tax year 2025, and first due in calendar year 2026, being the tax duplicate year 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028 and 2029; and

<u>Section 7.</u> The additional tax is to be levied on the entire territory of the Village in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

<u>Section 8.</u> The date of the election at which the questions of the tax shall appear on the ballots November 5, 2024; and

<u>Section 9.</u> The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the Village of Elmore in Ottawa and Sandusky Counties, Ohio; and

<u>Section 10.</u> The tax year in which the tax shall be levied is 2025, and the calendar year in which the tax shall first be collected is 2026; and

<u>Section 11.</u> Ottawa and Sandusky Counties are the only counties upon which the Village of Elmore has territory.

<u>Section 12.</u> This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoptions of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council, and all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in compliance with Ohio law, including O.R.C. 121.22.

<u>Section 13.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Elmore to provide for uninterrupted funding needed for the current expenses of the Village and shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
