

**VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY**

**Ordinance No. 2020-04-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE TITLE IX, CHAPTER 96, NUISANCES, SECTION 96.01, ENUMERATION OF PARTICULAR NUISANCES**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Illinois has issued a disaster proclamation relative to the COVID-19 pandemic and has issued Executive Order 2020-10 requiring the closure of certain businesses, which executive order is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board deems it necessary and in the best interests of the Village to expand the list of public nuisances to include violations of the terms of the aforesaid Executive Order 2020-10.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 2. THE VILLAGE CODE TITLE IX, CHAPTER 96, NUISANCES, SECTION 96.01, ENUMERATION OF PARTICULAR NUISANCES is hereby amended to add a subparagraph (I) to said section 96.01 which shall read as follows:

(I) Executive orders in furtherance of the public health, safety, and welfare lawfully issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois by the powers vested in Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305, and consistent with the powers in public health laws, shall be observed and obeyed by the citizens of Hanna City and those within its borders. Violations of these lawful executive orders are hereby declared a public nuisance and it shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, joint adventure, association, society, club, trustee or corporation or any officer, agent, employee, factor or any kind of personal representative to violate any Executive Order of the Governor of the State of Illinois pursuant to the Governor's powers under Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305.


(a) Any person or entity having been found guilty of violating any Executive Order of the Governor of the State of Illinois pursuant to the Governor's powers under Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305 shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$750 per day that such offense continues;

(b) Any person or entity having been found guilty of violating this subparagraph shall be liable for a fine on a continuing basis and shall be subject to a \$750 fine for each day that said violation continues.

Section 3 Effective Immediately This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage due to the immediate urgency of implementing the Illinois Governor's Emergency Orders issued in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
