AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §51.033 RELATING TO
PROPERTY OWNER CONNECTIONS TO EXISTING SEWERS

WHEREAS city ordinance §51.033 embodies the Utility Commission's previous policy that customers are responsible for maintaining and repairing their own lines from their building to the sewer main, which is deemed unnecessarily burdensome to the citizens of LaGrange and customers of the LaGrange Utilities Commission; and

WHEREAS the new policy requires that a clean-out be installed at the property line so that in the future the property owner will only be responsible for service from the house to the clean out and the Utility Commission will be responsible for the remainder of the connection to the main.

Now therefore, it is hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of LaGrange, Kentucky that the aforesaid ordinance shall read as follows:

51.033 Use of Existing Sewers


Existing building sewers may be used in connection with new buildings only when they are found on examination and test by the Director, to meet all requirements of this chapter. Permit and inspection fees for new users of existing building sewers shall be the same as for new building sewers. ~~Each landowner/customer shall be liable for his or her sewer service lateral to the main.~~


