AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-465 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO THE CORRIDORS COMMISSION TO INCREASE THE NON-VOTING MEMBERS FROM SIX (6) TO SEVEN (7) BY ADDING A COMPLETE STREETS MANAGER REPRESENTATIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 -That Section 2-465 of the Code of Ordinances, Lexington-Fayette

Urban County Government, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-465. Membership.
