AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-129(4) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO PARKING OF VEHICLES IN ANY RESIDENTIAL SECTION TO ALLOW ANY CITATION OFFICER TO CITE FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:


Section 1 – That Section 18-129(4) of the Code of Ordinances of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

(4) Citation officer as authorized in Section 14-10 of the Code of Ordinances or any safety officer, parking officer, peace officer is authorized to issue citations for violations of this section.


Section 2 – That this Ordinance shall become effective upon the date of its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 62 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN OF THE BUDGETS OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO REFLECT CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$155.00 FOR THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND RECREATION FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE OVERDOSE AWARENESS DAY EVENT, SCHEDULE NO. 0008.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for the Division of Parks and Recreation for funds in the amount of \$155.00 from Neighborhood Development Funds to support the Overdose Awareness Day event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for the Division of Parks and Recreation for funds in the amount of \$155.00 from Neighborhood Development Funds to support the Overdose Awareness Day event and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:

) Re-appropriations within the General Services District – General Fund which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of this fund.

Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in Schedule No. 0008, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
