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SEC. 66.1. LANDSCAPE WASTE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF  
MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 66. Solid Waste. Article I. Solid Waste. Sec. 66.1. Landscape Waste of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 66.1. Landscape waste.

- (a) Landscape waste as used in this section shall be defined as in section 8-1 of this code.
- (b) This section shall apply to all landscape waste to be picked up by the city refuse system.
- (c) It shall be unlawful to dump or place any landscape waste on any premises in the city without the consent of the owner or occupant of such premises.
- (d) The owner or occupant of the premises shall place all landscape waste to be collected by the city refuse system on the city right-of-way next to the improved surface of the city street. Landscape waste shall be six feet in length or shorter.
- (e) All landscape waste to be picked up by the city refuse system shall be placed for pickup either loose or in biodegradable paper bags. Any landscape waste that is not placed for pickup either loose or in biodegradable paper bags shall be left and not picked up by the city.
- (f) The superintendent of public works shall have charge of the collection of landscape waste from the city.
- (g) Contractors who remove trees and other plant materials within the city limits or from the property of city electrical utility customers shall remove that landscape waste from the city or take the material to a place assigned for such by the city at 1768 East Plant Road.
- ~~(g)~~(h) Anyone who places trees and/or other plant materials in the city site from outside the city limits shall be fined according to section 1-5 of this code.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and

approval as provided by law.
