AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS. DIVISION 1. GENERALLY. SECTION 70-42. LIABILITY OF PERSONS TO CITY FOR DAMAGE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 70. Streets, Sidewalks and other Public Places. Article II. Excavations. Division 1. Generally. Section 70-42. Liability of Persons to City for Damage of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Section 70-42. Liability of persons to city for damage.

If any person violates any provision of this article and any person or property in consequence thereof is injured or damaged, the person so guilty of such violation shall be liable to the city in relation thereto, and no prosecution or other proceeding by the city of such person for any penalty imposed for a violation shall constitute a bar to such action by the city for such damages.

Unless otherwise provided, any person or entity violating any provision of this Article shall be financially responsible for any necessary repairs and other costs associated with the proper restoration of the Works and Safety of the City license to engage in such work. In addition, said person or entity violating any of the provisions herein shall be fined not more than Two Hundred-fifty Dollars (\$250) per day per violation. Each day's continued violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.


