AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS. DIVISION 2. PERMIT. SECTION 70-79. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 70. Streets, Sidewalks and other Public Places. Article II. Excavations. Division 2. Permit. Section 70-79. Certificate of Insurance of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Section 70-79. Certificate of Insurance.

No excavation permit shall be issued unless and until the applicant therefore has filed with the city collector a certificate of insurance or other proof of insurance in a minimum following amount: ~~of \$500,000.00 for comprehensive general liability.~~

1. Combined bodily injury and property damage – Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00)
2. Any occurrence relative to which there is injury or death to one (1) or more persons – Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00).
3. Property damage – One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).
4. The minimum bond amount shall be Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00). Permits exceeding one thousand (1,000) square feet of disturbed area may require additional bonding amounts at the request of the Public Works Department. Bonding amounts will be calculated on a case-by-case basis as determined by the cost of restoration of the Right-of-Way.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.
