AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS. DIVISION 1. GENERALLY. SECTION 70-48. PROTECTIVE MEASURES AND ROUTING OF TRAFFIC OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 70. Streets, Sidewalks and other Public Places. Article II. Excavations. Division 1. Generally. Section 70-48. Protective Measures and Routing of Traffic of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:
Section 70-48. Protective measures and routing of traffic.

It shall be the duty of every person cutting or making an excavation in or upon any public place to place and maintain barriers and warning devices necessary for the safety of the general public as described in the Illinois Department of Transportation Manual for Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.


