AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS. DIVISION 2. PERMIT. SECTION 70-78. FEES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 70. Streets, Sidewalks and other Public Places. Article II. Excavations. Division 2. Permit. Section 70-78. Fees of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Section 70-78. Fees.

~~The fee for each permit shall be \$25.00, and shall be paid at the time the application is submitted to the city collector.~~

A. For each permit to engage in working in the Right-of-Way of this City, in addition to making an application to the Public Works Department the person or entity shall pay the City of Marshall a base fee in the amount of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) plus the applicable following fee:

1. The fee for excavations or other disturbed surfaces shall be Twenty-Five Cents (\$0.25) per square foot for surface area disturbed.
2. The fee for directional drilling or other types of boring underground shall be Fifteen Cents (\$0.15) per linear foot of bored line.

B. Fees below shall be in addition to the base fee:

1. Any work which requires the closing of a street to vehicular traffic, flagging or lane restrictions, will have an additional charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per lane per day of roadway restriction. Partial lane restriction shall be considered as a single lane restriction.
2. For permits exceeding a one-year timeframe, the cost to renew a permit shall be One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00).

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.
