ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 41

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES
FOR THE CITY OF MT. VERNON, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025
BEGINNING MAY 1, 2024, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2025.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mt. Vernon, Illinois did on the 15th day of April 2024 adopt its Budget Ordinance, after the tentative budget having been available for public inspection at least 10 days prior to the adoption thereof, all as set forth in Ordinance No. 2024-11; and

WHEREAS, a true and certified copy of Ordinance No. 2024-11 has been filed with the County Clerk of Jefferson County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the public interests for the City Council of the City of Mt. Vernon, Illinois to levy and collect taxes for all of such corporate purposes as provided in 65 ILCS 5/8-3-1; and

WHEREAS, the People of the City of Mt. Vernon adopted the Home Rule provision contained in Article VII(6) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois by election and, pursuant thereto, the limitations upon its levies of taxes no longer are applicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Vernon, Illinois as follows:

Section I. Levy.

There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Mt. Vernon, Illinois for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2024, and ending April 30, 2025, the following amounts for the following specific purposes as provided in said Budget Ordinance:

A. General Corporate Operations

Section 3.

In addition to the foregoing, the following levies have been made by the City Council and are not required to be separately levied annually, but are to be extended annually unless otherwise abated by the Council:

Levy for 2020 Bonds authorized by Ordinance 2020-31

THE LEVIES FOR THE CURRENT TAX YEAR (ONLY) AUTHORIZED BY THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED ORDINANCES **ARE HEREBY ABATED** SO THAT NO TAX LEVIES SHALL BE EXTENDED FOR THE CURRENT TAX YEAR. TAXES AUTHORIZED TO BE LEVIED PURSUANT TO THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED ORDINANCES SHALL BE EXTENDED IN FUTURE YEARS AS PROVIDED BY SAID ORDINANCES UNLESS OTHERWISE ABATED.

Section 4.

All monies received by the City of Mt. Vernon shall be paid to the City Finance Director, and the City Finance Director shall place all monies received by levy of taxes into the foregoing respective Funds for which a levy is made. The City Finance Director shall pay out none of the funds herein appropriated except in the manner provided by law and ordinance.

Section 5.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


