ORDINANCE NO.10646 (NEW SERIES)

ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS IN TITLE 7
REGARDING HIGHWAYS AND TRAFFIC IN THE
SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1: The County completes periodic reviews of adopted ordinances to remove or amend obsolete and outdated language. In accordance with this practice, Title 7 of the County Code of Regulatory Ordinances, commencing with Section 71.101, was reviewed and amendments were recommended to reflect current business practices and applicable law.

Section 2: The following portions of Sections within Title 7 of the County Code of Regulatory Ordinances are hereby amended as follows:

Section 71.101.(i) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.101.(i) DEFINITIONS.

(i) "DIRECTOR" means the Director of Department of Public Works of this County, and the Director of Planning and Development Services as ex-officio Director of Department of Public Works when performing tasks pursuant to delegations of authority from the Director of Department of Public Works.

Section 71.116. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.116. PURCHASE OF SPECIFICATIONS.

Copies of the specifications entitled "The Standard Specifications, Public Works Construction", referred to in this division may be obtained online at the County of San Diego Department of Public Works website.

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Section 71.302. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.302 . PERMIT REQUIRED.

No person or the contractor of any person excepting the contractor of this County for highway construction, improvement or repair, shall make or cause to be made any encroachment including an excavation, fill or obstruction in, over, along, or across or through any highway without first obtaining from the Director a permit so to do.

Section 71.402. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.402. PERMIT REQUIRED.

No person shall construct or repair any curb, sidewalk, gutter, commercial driveway, roadway surface, retaining wall, storm drain or culvert or other work of any nature in, over, along, across or through any highway, or cause the same to be done, without first obtaining from the Director a permit so to do.

Section 71.403.(c) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.403.(c) APPLICATION FOR PERMIT.

(c) Such other information as the Director may require.

Section 71.404. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.404. PLANS REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION.

If in the opinion of the Director the work proposed to be done requires the making of plans or the setting of stakes, or both, the Director may require the application to be

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accompanied by the necessary plans, which plans shall be prepared by a competent engineer.

Section 71.406. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.406. WORK TO BE FULL LENGTH OF STREET.

If, in the opinion of the Director, the construction of any length of curb or sidewalk less than the full length of a street between street intersections would create a condition hazardous to the traveling public using the street upon which it is proposed to install the curb or sidewalk, the Director may refuse to issue a permit for the construction of curb or sidewalk for any length less than the full length of said street between intersecting streets.

Section 71.408.(a) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.408.(a) ENGINEERING AND/OR INSPECTION SERVICES.

(a) An amount estimated by the Director to be equal to twice the actual cost of all necessary engineering review and inspection services.

Section 71.409.(a) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.409.(a) REFUND OR DEFICIENCY PAYMENT.

(a) Where the deposit has been made under Subsection (a) and (b) of Section 71.408, the Director shall deduct from the deposit the amount of the issuance fee and the actual cost to the County of the required engineering and inspection. If such cost and fee is less than the deposit, the difference shall be refunded to the person making the deposit in the same manner as provided by law for the repayment of trust moneys.

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Section 71.410. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.410. RELOCATION COSTS.

If so required by the Director, the permittee shall make proper arrangements for, and bear the cost of relocating any structure, public utility, tree or shrub, where such relocation is made necessary by the proposed work for which a permit is issued. The Director may elect to do the necessary relocation. In such case the permittee shall deposit with the Director a sum of money estimated to be sufficient to pay the cost thereof. After such relocation, a refund shall be paid to, or a deficiency shall be paid by, the permittee as provided in Section 71.409.

Section 71.411. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.411. DEPOSIT FOR RESETTING STAKES.

If any stakes set for any work covered by this chapter are disturbed or destroyed and it becomes necessary to set additional stakes, the permittee shall deposit a sum estimated by the Director to be sufficient to pay the cost of setting such additional stakes. The Director shall set the additional stakes. After such setting, a refund shall be paid to, or a deficiency shall be paid by, the permittee as provided in Section 71.409.

Section 71.412. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.412. REFUND UPON REVOCATION.

When a permit has been revoked by the Director, the permittee may obtain a refund of any unused fee paid or unused deposit made. No part of any issuance fee may

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be refunded.

Section 71.415. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.415. REVOCATION FOR DELAY.

Unless a good and sufficient reason exists for the failure of the permittee to comply with the provisions of Section 71.414, the Director may revoke the permit.

Section 71.417. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.417. LINES AND GRADES OBTAINED FROM DIRECTOR.

Section 71.418. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.418. PERFORMANCE ACCORDING TO PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS -- INSPECTION.

The permittee shall perform all work in accordance with the plans, if plans are made, and the specifications entitled "The Standard Specifications For Public Works Construction", on file with the Director, and, further, to the satisfaction of the Director.

The Director may waive inspection, if the Director believes such inspection is not necessary for the best interests of the County, provided, however, any such waiver shall be in writing.

Section 71.419. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.419. SUBSEQUENT CHANGE IN PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

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No change in any plans, if plans are made, or specifications shall be made unless approved in writing by the Director.

Section 71.420. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.420. REQUEST FOR INSPECTOR BEFORE WORK BEGINS.

Not less than 24 hours before the commencement of any work regulated by this chapter, the permittee shall apply in writing to the Director for an inspector therefor. Such application shall specify the day and hour when, and the location at which, the work will be commenced.

Section 71.421. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.421. APPROVAL OF CONCRETE FORMS.

No concrete shall be poured or placed until the Director has approved in writing the forms into which the concrete is to be poured or placed.

Section 71.422. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.422. WARNING LIGHTS.

A permittee shall place and maintain at each end of the work and not more than 50 feet apart along the side thereof, unless otherwise directed by the Director from sunset of each day until sunrise of the following day, until the work is entirely completed, flares or red warning lights. The permittee shall also place and maintain barriers not less than three feet high at each end of the work until the work is completed to the entire satisfaction of the Director.

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Section 71.425. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.425. CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE.

If the Director by survey or by inspection or by both ascertains that the work has been completed according to the requirements of the permit, issued therefor and all of the provisions of this division, the Director shall issue if requested so to do by the permittee, a certificate of acceptance which shall contain a statement of the location, nature, and extent of the work performed under the permit.

Section 71.427. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.427. DEFECTIVE WORK AND MATERIALS.

Upon order of the Director, any work or material which does not conform to the permit, the plans, if plans are made, and the specifications referred to in Sections 71.418 and 71.419 shall be removed and replaced so as to conform to said plans and specifications, notwithstanding that such work or material has been previously inspected, or approved, or accepted by the Director.

Section 71.428. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.428. DEFAULT OF PERMITTEE.

By applying for and obtaining a permit pursuant to this division, the permittee agrees with the County that in the event the permittee fails to comply promptly with the terms of the permit and perform and complete the work according to the plans, if any, and the specifications referred to in Sections 71.418 and 71.419, or fails to comply with any

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other provisions of this division, the County may elect to perform and complete the work, in which event the permittee shall pay to the County upon demand of the Director and prior to actual performance and completion of the work by the County or its contractor, the cost of performing and completing the work according to such permit, the plans, if any, and the specifications either by the use of the County's forces or by an independent contractor, whichever method the Director deems appropriate, and in the event the permittee fails to pay such cost to the County upon demand, the County may bring an action in a court of competent jurisdiction to recover such cost together with reasonable attorney's fees.

Section 71.501.(a) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.501.(a) PERMIT REQUIRED.

(a) No person shall trim, prune, cut, break, deface, destroy, burn or remove any tree, hedge, plant, shrub, or flower growing or to grow upon any County-owned public property within the unincorporated territory of the County unless authorized in writing to do so by the Director, or the Director, Department of Parks and Recreation, whichever is the appropriate County officer, or the Board.

Section 71.510. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.510. PERMIT REQUIRED.

No person shall plant any tree, hedge or shrub upon or within any County highway within the unincorporated territory of the County unless authorized in writing to do so by the Director.

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Section 71.512. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.512. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT -- DENIAL.

(a) No permit for the planting of a tree, shrub or hedge within any public or County highway shall be issued by the Director unless the species of the tree, shrub or hedge to be planted is approved by the Director. The permit for the planting of a tree, shrub or hedge may be issued upon such terms and conditions as the Director determines appropriate to protect persons and property or may be denied.

Section 71.609. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 71.609. ENCROACHMENT AND MATERIAL TESTING DEPOSIT.

Each applicant for a permit, in addition to payment of the issuance fee, shall place a deposit with the Director to guarantee the placement of protective measures if required, and the removal of the encroachment and restoration of the highway. The amount of the deposit shall be prescribed by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 72.13. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.13. OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS.

"OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS" shall mean any device, whether electrically or mechanically operated, by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and proceed, and which is erected by authority of a public body or official having jurisdiction.

Section 72.14. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

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Section 72.14. OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.

"OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" shall mean any signs, signals, markings and devices consistent with this division, placed or erected by authority of a public body or official having jurisdiction for the purpose of regulating, warning or guiding traffic.

Section 72.20. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.20. SIDEWALK.

"SIDEWALK" shall mean that portion of the highway between the curb lines or edge of pavement and the adjacent property lines.

Section 72.21. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.21. STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

"STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION" or "CALTRANS" shall mean the Department of Transportation of the State of California.

Section 72.60. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.60. AUTHORIZATION OF SIGNS.

The Board shall by resolution determine and designate the size, shape and character of all official warning, regulatory, and guide signs, other than signs the size, shape and character of which have been established by CALTRANS pursuant to the Vehicle Code. The Road Commissioner may place and maintain, or cause to be placed and maintained, all official warning and guide signs necessary to the proper control of

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traffic and all regulatory signs required or authorized by this division or the Vehicle Code.

Section 72.125. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.125. BOARD MAY ESTABLISH NO PARKING-TOW AWAY ZONES.

(a) When the Board determines by resolution that it is necessary to establish no parking-tow away zones on certain highways or portions thereof as defined in Vehicle Code Section 22651 subparagraphs (k), (l), (m), or (n), the Road Commissioner shall appropriately sign or mark such highways or portions thereof, and when so signed or marked no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle on any such highway or portion thereof in violation of the restriction stated on or indicated by such signs or markings.

Section 72.135.(a)(5) of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.135.(a)(5) CURB MARKINGS TO INDICATE NO STOPPING AND PARKING REGULATIONS.

(5) Blue shall mean parking limited exclusively to the vehicles of persons with a disability.

The Sheriff of the County of San Diego and the Director of the Department of General Services (Office of Security Services), and if the County property involved is located within the boundaries of an incorporated city the police department of such city have the power to enforce this article and such resolutions.

Section 73.104. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 73.104. REMOVAL OF VEHICLES.

The Sheriff of San Diego County and the Director of the Department of General Services (Office of Security Services), and if the County property involved is located within the boundaries of an incorporated city, the police department of such city, may remove any motor vehicle parked, stopped or left standing contrary to this division or to a

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resolution regulating parking and, at the expense of the owner thereof, may either place such vehicle in a public parking lot or garage or impound the same in a County facility.

Section 73.105. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 73.105. ERECTION OF SIGNS.

The Department of General Services shall, and if the County property involved is located within the boundaries of an incorporated city the city may, erect or place appropriate signs on the County property involved, giving notice of the conditions and regulations imposed on the use by vehicles by Section 73.107 or pursuant to a resolution regulating parking.

Section 73.112. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 73.112. PARKING AT HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY FACILITIES.

Pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22519, and subject to the conditions and regulations imposed by this division and by resolutions adopted pursuant to Section 73.102 of the County Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the following regulations applicable to the stopping, parking and leaving standing of vehicles on parking facilities operated by the Health And Human Services Agency of the County of San Diego:

(a) Edgemoor Skilled Nursing Facility. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any attended or unattended vehicle at Edgemoor Skilled Nursing Facility, except as permitted by the provisions of the resolution of the Board of Supervisors adopted on March 28, 1967 as Item No. 36 and such additional resolutions regulating parking at Edgemoor Skilled Nursing Facility as may hereinafter be adopted by the Board of

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Supervisors.

(b) University Hospital. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any attended or unattended vehicle on County parking facilities at University Hospital except in accordance with the following conditions: Parking shall be restricted to vehicles bearing a Health And Human Services Agency parking sticker or permit, vehicles of persons who are either patients or visitors to the Health And Human Services Agency facility at University Hospital, governmental vehicles bearing an "E" license, and emergency vehicles. Each type of vehicles specified above shall be parked only in the areas designated for such type of vehicle by the Director of the Health And Human Services Agency, and appropriate signs shall be placed giving notice of these conditions.

(c) Administrative Offices. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any attended or unattended vehicle on County-operated parking facilities at the administrative offices in the vicinity of 6255 Mission Gorge Road, San Diego, except in accordance with the following conditions: Parking shall be limited to vehicles bearing a Health And Human Services Agency parking sticker or permit and vehicles of persons who are either patients, clients or visitors of said facility. In addition, three parking spaces shall be reserved for medical records vehicles and mail vehicles. Each type of vehicle specified above shall be parked only in the areas designated for such type of vehicle by the Director of the Health And Human Services Agency, and appropriate signs shall be placed giving notice of these conditions.

(d) Psychiatric Hospital of San Diego County. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any attended or unattended vehicle on County parking facilities at Psychiatric Hospital of San Diego County except in accordance with the following conditions: Parking shall be restricted to vehicles bearing a Health And Human Services Agency parking sticker or permit, vehicles of persons who are patients, clients or visitors of said facility, emergency vehicles, and vehicles used for delivery of goods to said facility. Each type of

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vehicle specified above shall be parked only in the areas designated for such type of vehicle by the Director of the Health And Human Services Agency, and appropriate signs shall be placed giving notice of these conditions.

Section 78.210. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 78.210. COSTS OF ABATEMENT UPON SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS.

Upon entry of a second or subsequent civil or criminal judgment against a property owner within a two year period for violations of this division, a court may order the owner to pay the costs of administration and removal of the abatement.

Section 78.301. of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 78.301. AUTHORITY TO REMOVE ABANDONED VEHICLES.

(a) Any officer or designated employee, who has reasonable grounds to believe that a vehicle has been abandoned, as determined pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22523, upon a highway or upon public or private property without the express consent of the owner or person in lawful possession or control of the property, may remove the vehicle from a highway or from public or private property pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22669.

(b) Any person performing under a franchise or contract awarded by a service authority for the abatement of abandoned vehicles may remove a vehicle from a highway or place to which it has been removed pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22654(c) or from public or private property, after determination by an officer or designated employee that the vehicle is abandoned, as determined pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22523.


(c) A state, county, or city employee, other than a peace officer or employee of a sheriff's department or a city police department, designated to remove vehicles pursuant to this section may do so only after he or she has mailed or personally delivered a written report identifying the vehicle and its location to the office of the Department of the California Highway Patrol located nearest to the vehicle.

(d) Motor vehicles which are parked, resting, or otherwise immobilized on any highway or public right-of-way and which lack an engine, transmission, wheels, tires, doors, windshield, or any other part or equipment necessary to operate safely on the highways of this state, are hereby declared a hazard to public health, safety, and welfare and may be removed immediately upon discovery by a peace officer or other designated employee of the state, county, or city.
