

ORDINANCE NO. 10757 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 175.3 OF ARTICLE XII-A OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO ADOPTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR COUNTY LIBRARY FACILITIES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 175.3 of the County of San Diego Administrative Code is amended to read, as follows:

SEC. 175.3. DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR.


The Director shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors and shall be subject to the general supervision of the Chief Administrative Officer. The Director shall exercise general supervision over all functions of the Department pursuant to Section 700 of the Charter. The Director shall adopt and enforce rules and regulations for all County Library facilities.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Daily Transcript, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
