**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RULE 8(a) OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY
ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARDS AND ASSESSMENT HEARING OFFICERS
RULES OF PROCEDURE RELATING TO FEES CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF THE
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR WRITTEN ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD
FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:


Section 1. Rule 8(a) of the San Diego County Assessment Appeals Boards and Assessment Hearing Officers Rules of Procedure is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

If an applicant or the assessor desires written findings of fact, the request must be submitted in writing and payment of the fee made to the clerk before commencement of the hearing. The requesting party may abandon the request and waive findings at the conclusion of the hearing. If the requesting party abandons the request, at this time, the other party may orally or in writing renew the request at the conclusion of the hearing, and accompany the request with payment of the required fee or deposit. If, at the conclusion of the hearing, a party requesting written findings has failed to pay the required fee or deposit, the board need not prepare written findings. The board may deny a request made after the conclusion of the hearing that seeks to waive written findings. A fee of four hundred ninety dollars (\$490) shall be charged to each applicant initially requesting findings or renewing a request upon abandonment by the assessor. The county must provide findings within 45 days after the final determination of the board, and shall accompany them with a notice that a request for a transcript of the hearing must be made within 60 days after the determination. (See Section 14 for other matters with regard to a transcript.)

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
