

ORDINANCE NO. 9585 (N.S.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 320.2 THROUGH 320.5  
OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO  
RELATING TO THE GENERAL SUPERVISION OF THE  
COUNTY TECHNOLOGY OFFICE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that:

(a) On May 11, 1999, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 9034 (N.S.), which established a County Technology Office under the general supervision of the Chief Technology Officer.

(b) On June 19, 2001 the ordinance was amended in Ordinance 9346 (N.S.) to change the appointing authority of the County Technology Office from the Chief Technology Officer to the Executive Director, County Technology Office.

(c) Subsequently, the management of information technology in the County has evolved and a different management structure is now appropriate. It is also appropriate to amend the ordinance to change the appointing authority of the County Technology Office from the Executive Director, County Technology Office to the Chief Information Officer.

(d) This change allows for the consolidation of all countywide technology and information issues under the Chief Information Officer.

Section 2. Section 320.2 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 320.2. RECOGNITION OF THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER.

There is in the County and in the Office the position of Chief Information Officer. Such positions shall be filled by appointment by the Chief Administrative Officer in accordance with the County Charter, applicable rules and regulations relating to the Unclassified Service, and County ordinances.

Section 3. Section 320.3 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 320.3. DUTIES OF CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER.

The Chief Information Officer shall act under the supervision of the Chief Administrative Officer. The Chief Information Officer shall exercise general supervision over all functions of the Office and shall enforce such rules and regulations as prescribed and approved by the Board.

Section 5. Section 320.4 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 320.4. CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER TO APPOINT PERSONNEL.

The Chief Information Officer shall appoint and employ such personnel as may be necessary to conduct the business of the Office. All appointments and employments made by the Chief Information Officer shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the County Charter, Rules of the Civil Service Commission, Unclassified Service and County ordinances.

Section 6. Section 320.5 of the San Diego County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 320.5. CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER TO PREPARE BUDGET AND SUPERVISE EXPENDITURES.**

The Chief Information Officer shall prepare and submit to the Chief Administrative Officer the required annual itemized estimates of expenditures and revenues for the Office. The Chief Information Officer shall review and make recommendations upon all services and resources that may be incorporated within any other office, Office or agency. The Chief Information Officer shall supervise the expenditures of all funds allocated to the Office and review and make recommendations on the expenditures of those funds allocated to other County offices, departments and agencies for information systems services and resources.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary thereof shall be published in the San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
