

ORDINANCE 9738 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES TITLE 2 AND TITLE 3, DIVISION 2 AND DIVISION 9 RELATING TO LICENSES, BUSINESS REGULATIONS AND BUSINESS TAXES AND PUBLIC SAFETY MORALE AND WELFARE.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that there is a need to amend or create new sunset dates for the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances as described below. This ordinance will allow the County to continue to ensure that obsolete provisions are deleted and the remaining code provisions reflect current Board standards and directives.

Section 2. San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances Title 2 has no amendments and requires a new sunset date of December 31, 2011.

Section 3. San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances Title 3, Division 2, Chapter 8.5 PROHIBITION OF THE SALE OF TOBACCO ITEMS THROUGH VENDING MACHINES SEC. 32.850 – 32.853 are repealed.

Section 4. San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances Title 3, Division 2, Chapter 13 DAYTIME LOITERING OF JUVENILES ON SCHOOL DAYS requires a new sunset date of December 31, 2011 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 32.1302 DEFINITIONS.

For purposes of this chapter the following terms are defined as follows:

(a) through (b) [No change]

(c) "Parent" means a person who is the natural, adoptive or step parent of a person. "Parent" includes a court appointed guardian or other person eighteen (18) years of age or older, authorized by the parent, by a court order, or by a court appointed guardian to have the care and custody of the person.

(d) through (f) [No changes]

SEC. 32.1303 DAYTIME LOITERING OF JUVENILES IN PUBLIC PLACES ON SCHOOL DAYS.

(b) (1) through (2) [No change]

(b) (3) When the juvenile is going directly to, or coming directly from, his or her place of school-approved employment;

(b) (4) through (5) [No change]

(b) (6) When the juvenile is going directly to, or coming from a compulsory alternative education program activity;

(b) (7) through (10) [No change]

Section 5. San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances Title 3, Division 2, Chapter 14 Limits on Sales of Products Containing Ephedrine requires a new sunset date of December 31, 2011 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 32.1403 LIMITS ON THE SALE OR PURCHASE OF EPHEDRINE PRODUCTS.

(a) It is unlawful for any customer on any single day to purchase or acquire more than three packages of products containing ephedrine.

(b) It is unlawful for any customer on any single day to purchase or acquire products containing ephedrine where the total count exceeds 100.

Section 6. San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances Title 3, Division 9, Chapter 1 CURFEW requires a new sunset date of December 31, 2011 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 39.102 DEFINITIONS FOR CURFEW PROVISIONS.

For purposes of this chapter the following terms shall be defined as follows:

(a) through (g) [No change]

(h) "Responsible adult" means a person at least eighteen (18) years of age, authorized by a parent or guardian to have the care and custody of a minor. However, if the true parent or guardian cannot be located by investigating officers to verify that authorization was given, this subsection will not apply.

(i) [No change]

Section 7. The effective date of this ordinance is October 27, 2005.
