

**ORDINANCE NO 9752 (NEW SERIES)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
AUTHORIZED CLASSIFICATIONS, CHARACTERISTICS, AND COMPENSATION.**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** Appendix One of the Compensation Ordinance is hereby amended by establishing compensation for the following classifications:

**Section 2.** Section 3.3.1 of the Compensation Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows regarding the District Attorney, Sheriff, and the Treasurer/Tax Collector’s annual salary:

SECTION 3.3.1: OTHER ELECTIVE OFFICERS' SALARIES. The following elective officers in the Unclassified Service shall be paid at the following annual salary rates:
