ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF NO PARKING
ZONES IN YOE BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS
AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Yoe Borough Council, York
County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1. Definitions.

"Parking" is hereby defined as the standing of a vehicle,
except a police or fire department vehicle or ambulance, whether occupied
or not, upon the highway other than temporary for the purpose and while
actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic
regulations or traffic signs or signals.

Section 2.

Borough Council shall from time to time by resolution establish
no parking zones.

Section 3.

NO PARKING signs shall be erected marking the zones established
pursuant to Section 2 above in accordance with details and specifications
furnished and approved by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania.

Section 4.

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on any street
or portion thereof posted "No Parking".

Section 5.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance
shall be subject to fine, imprisonment and costs and procedures as stated
in the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 75 Pa. C.S.,
which fine shall be disposed of as stated in the aforesaid Vehicle Code;

provided , however, that a penalty of \$10.00 for violation of Section 4, hereof is prescribed under the following conditions: that the police officer shall attach to the vehicle or hand to the operator any notice that such vehicle is parked or stopped or standing in violation of this Ordinance, which notice shall contain instructions that if such owner or operator shall report to the Police Department within 5 days after the time of such notice, or place said sum within the envelope provided, in a fine box located as specified, within such time limit, the same shall save such violator from prosecution and from payment of the above stated fine and costs.

Section 6.

This act shall take affect thrity (30) days after its passage.
